## Treasurer's Report- Statements read by Michelle Schmidberger

- Bank Statement through the end of August: Savings \$14,442.13. Checking \$5.
- Went through yearly budget line by line.
- Teachers have to submit for approval what they are purchasing.
- Remove Sara Musayeb from bank account and add Katie Fohey. Voted unanimously in favor.
- Voted to change the budget for Bingo event. Courtney wants it to be a family fun night rather than fundraiser. Decreasing revenue from Bingo by \$500. And increasing budget in family fun night by \$500. Voted unanimously in favor.
- Voted to move \$1,000 from Previously committed small project funds to increase Fall Fest budget to \$2,000. Voted unanimously in favor.
